The Texas Bible Chair Foundation cordially invites you to attend our next **Clergy Leadership Institute**. It will be held on **Saturday, May 7, 2011 from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm** at **South Shore Christian Church, 4710 South Alameda Street, Corpus Christi, Texas.**

Please note this is a different location than the January Clergy Leadership Institute AND A DIFFERENT DATE THAN ORIGINALLY ADVERTISED.

You do not have to have participated in any of our previous sessions to attend the May Clergy Leadership Institute. Each Institute is designed to stand on its own.

The May session will focus on **Multi-Cultural Pastoral Care**. The workshops will be led by **Rev. Allen C. Allen**, Bluebonnet Area Interim Area Minister, and **Rev. Joe Jaime**, Chaplain, Valley Baptist Hospital, Harlingen. The sessions will be available in both English and Spanish, if needed.

During our Clergy Leadership Institutes over the past three years, we averaged approximately 25 clergy in attendance at each session. The Institutes are designed for both ordained and licensed clergy as well as men and women who are exploring a call to vocational ministry. Bluebonnet Area licensed ministers will receive Continuing Education units from the BBA Department of Ministry for attending the entire day. CEU certificates will be distributed following the Closing Worship service. The courses are taught by ordained ministers and other scholars with graduate-level degrees.

Attached is a registration form for you to use. Limited scholarships are available. We would encourage any church or individual who is able to send an extra registration fee in order to make more scholarship money available for this training.

Dear Ministers, Youth Directors, and Youth Sponsors,

Summer Camp 2011 is rapidly approaching! Enclosed you will find registration materials and camp information for all of our summer camps. Please make sure to read ALL the information so you can help us inform the parents about camps!

The forms are all in white for your ease when duplicating. The Registration Form has been updated, so please use the one that says "Youth" in the upper left corner and has "2011" on it.

Please be sure that your camper, the parent, the notary, and the minister all complete necessary information contained on the form. We strongly suggest each church advertise a Camp Sign-Up Sunday with a notary present. This makes completing the form much easier on everyone. All signatures, which can be found on the front page of the Registration Form, are required. Payment should be made out to the *Bluebonnet Area* on a church check. Please do not send part of the payment on a parent check and the other part on a church check, this is very difficult to process.

Please make every effort to submit completed original forms to the Area office prior to the deadlines. No registrations will be accepted after the final deadline for each event. We get lots of phone calls and e-mails at the last minute. It is very difficult for Camp Directors to plan and prepare for campers with last minute additions! We want as many kids as possible to go to each camp. Please turn your forms in *early*. Make sure to have your Church Camp Registration Day **before** the registration deadline! If you have one or two kids you are still waiting on, send in the completed forms and the regular fee will only be assessed to the stragglers.

Please remember, summer camp is different from rallies. In order to serve as a Small Group Leader for summer camp, you have to attend sexual misconduct training and pass an exam (this occurs at camp). You have to have a background check completed by the Area Office. You have to be invited by the Director. Many of our staffs are being formed or have been completed. If you are interested in volunteering for a camp, please contact the Area Office or me. Adults who volunteer themselves at the last minute will not be permitted to remain at camp!

BBA/CPA CAMPING PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET

WHERE ARE THE CAMPS HELD?

All camps are conducted at the Disciple Oaks Retreat Center located just a few miles south of Gonzales, Texas. Address: 673 Private Road 3381 - Gonzales, Texas 78629.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Carefully fill out the Registration Form (both sides) and have the required persons read and sign the Form in the appropriate places. **THEN HAVE THE FORM NOTARIZED.** Obtain a check or money order for the appropriate camp fee made payable to the Coastal Plains Area. Please make sure that payment is for the full fee. **We realize that many churches pay a portion of camp fees, but only one check or money order for the full fee should be submitted. In other words, please do not send two checks: for example, one check for ½ the camp fee from your parent/guardian and another check for ½ the camp fee from your church.** The best plan is for your church to write one check for the full registration fees for all youth who will be attending the camp from your church and have the youths' parents/guardians reimburse the church for the portions that they are responsible for paying. Send the Registration Form and fee payment to the BBA/CPA Office at the address shown on the Registration Form. Registration is not considered complete until the Form and fee, as described above, are received in the CPA Office. **NO PART OF THE REGISTRATION PROCESS MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED BY TELEPHONE! NEITHER FAXED REGISTRATION FORMS NOR E-MAIL RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

WHEN ARE THE REGISTRATION DEADLINES?

The registration deadlines are shown on the tri-folded brochure that was included with this information brochure. Please note that there is a discounted registration fee for those who register by an earlier date. *The only person(s) authorized to grant an exception to the registration deadline for a camp is the Director(s) for that camp.* You may contact a Director by calling the BBA Office (210-822-4345) or CPA Office (713-789-8822) which will make the necessary arrangements for your contact. **Campers will not be allowed to stay at camp unless the BBA/CPA Office has processed your Form.**

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP TIMES

Information regarding drop-off and pick-up times for campers attending camp will be included in the letter from the Camp Director(s) prior to camp. Emergencies do happen, but please call and notify the Camp Director of a delayed arrival.

THINGS TO BRING AND NOT BRING

Every camper whose registration is accepted will receive a letter from the Camp Director(s), which will include a list of items to bring. Such items typically include: daily changes of clean shorts, shirts, underclothes and socks; one or two swim suits; one swimming towel and one bath towel; "flip-flop" or equivalent shoes for pool and shower; toiletries (soap, toothpaste, tooth brush, hair brush, shampoo); hygiene articles; two pairs of tennis shoes; dirty clothes bag; sleeping bag or two flat (single) sheets (no fitted sheets) and a medium weight bed spread or blanket; pillow; hat; sun glasses; sun screen or lotion; flashlight with batteries; insect repellent; Bible; two or three pens; stationery, stamps, envelopes, and addresses; camera and film; money for candy and soft drinks from the Sugar Shack (no more than \$2.00 per day); money for souvenirs from the Sugar Shack (optional-souvenirs may be purchased at drop-off and pick-up times); items that are helpful in skits (funny hats, wigs, CD of stage sounds, etc.); personal first aid products. It is highly recommended that the camper's name be marked on everything with an indelible marker.

Items which are **NOT** allowed at camp include: fireworks, illegal drugs, alcohol, guns and other firearms, knives. Things which should not be brought to camp include: expensive clothes and jewelry, prized personal belongings (watches, lockets, photographs with sentimental significance); candy, cookies and other food and drink items; silly string, money (except for the Sugar Shack and souvenirs).

iPods, MP3 players and portable CD players **MAY** be allowed for use **ONLY** during rest periods. The Director's letter will specifically state whether these items will be permitted.

SENDING MAIL AND PACKAGES TO YOUR CAMPER

Campers love to get mail and packages and we encourage families and friends to send them. But, there are a few things that should be kept in mind. Campers are not allowed to eat or store food in the dormitory areas and there is no secure area for them to keep food items in the recreational area. So, if someone sends a package with lots of candy and other food items, it may make a camper deliriously happy and sick as he or she tries to eat everything at one time to avoid the possibility of losing it. Of course, they could always share with the other campers (but usually do not).

Also, remember that it is HOT in Gonzales, Texas in the summer time. And chocolate and similar items melt even while in route to camp via U.S. Mail or UPS or FedEx (or whatever). Please allow several days for mail (especially packages) to get to the Disciple Oaks Retreat Center. Gonzales does not have a huge Post Office or a UPS Office. Many families and friends who send packages send them a day or two before the camp begins. Packages which arrive at the camp after the camp is over are not returned to the senders.

TELEPHONE CALLS

The **telephone number** of the Disciple Oaks Retreat Center Office is **1-830-437-2900**. This number should **NOT** be called in an attempt to contact a camper for a casual conversation. It is for business and emergency use only. Parents/Guardians and others may also call the BBA Office (210-822-4345) or the CPA Office (713-789-8822) for business and emergency matters.

Campers are not allowed to make telephone calls to their homes or other places for social reasons, including resolving homesickness.

NURSE AND MEDICATIONS

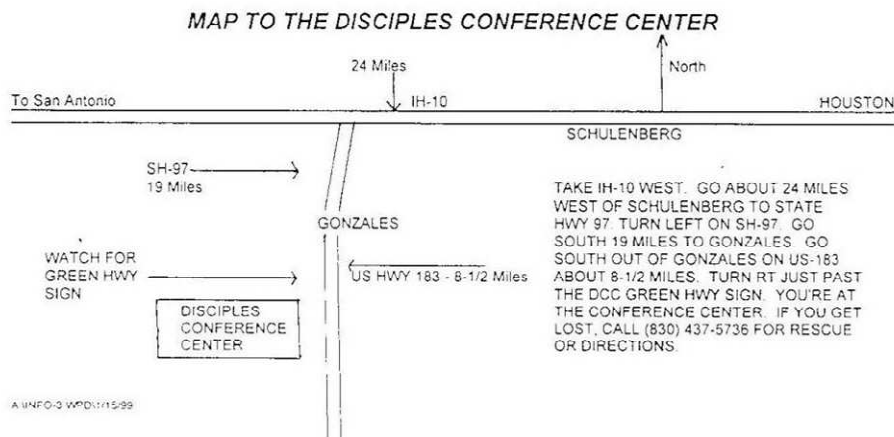
The camp has a person who will serve as the Camp Nurse. This person has received the necessary training and certification to meet the requirements of the governmental and accreditation agencies, which have authority over the camp facility.

At the time of arrival, all campers who will be on medications during the camp must meet with the Camp Nurse. In general, all medications must be turned over to the Camp Nurse for storage and dispensing to the campers at the prescribed times. The nurse may assign the dispensing of medications to the camper or a Director/Small Group Leader depending upon the nature of the camper's condition, type of medication, dependency upon the medication, and the camper's maturity level.

Please make sure that a camper who must receive medication during camp brings a sufficient quantity of the medication with him/her and that the medication arrives in the original container with dosage and storage instructions. **Campers who take medication for psychological or attention disorders need their medicine for a good camping experience. Please send such medicine with the camper unless otherwise directed by a health care professional.**

GROUP PHOTOGRAPH

A group photograph will be made at each camp. The cost for this photograph is included in the camp fee. Depending upon the arrangements for making and processing the photographs, they may be distributed before camp ends or mailed to the campers at a later date.
